**\$17,906\***

## This funding will be used to:

- achieve  $\geq$  100% of students in Prep–Year 6 at ‘C’ or above in English (including ICP students)
- achieve 100% of Year 3 and 5 students  $\geq$  National Minimum Standard in NAPLAN Reading (excluding ICP students)
- achieve 25% of students in Upper Two Bands in NAPLAN Reading in Years 3 and 5
- achieve 80% of Year 3 and 5 students attaining Mean Scale Score  $\geq$  the nation in NAPLAN Reading.

## Our initiatives include:

- embedding short-term data cycles, including monitoring and analysis of sight word and reading levels, to inform best practice in the teaching of reading
- developing staff capacity by embedding the Instructional Coaching Cycle (co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect, co-assess) during guided reading
- increasing professional engagement through focused professional development in the areas of reading comprehension, decoding strategies, phonics and vocabulary (MSV)
- using a Learning Support teacher to develop, implement and review Individual Curriculum Plans, with input from key stakeholders.
